

AMMENDMENTS TO THE K OF C DART RULES WRITTEN 11-16-86  
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THIS CHANGE WAS BROUGHT UP, DISCUSSED, VOTED ON, AND ACCEPTED BY THE CAPTAINS PRESENT AT THE LEAGUE CAPTAINS MEETING, HELD AUG 31, 1992.

ALL TEAMS WERE PRESENT AT THE MEETING.

NEW SHOOTER WILL COME IN AT A 30 AVERAGE, UNLESS HE SHOT IN ANOTHER LEAGUE AND HAS AN ESTABLISH AVERAGE. WE WILL THEN USE HIS ESTABLISHED AVERAGE.

IF NEW SHOOTER MISREPRESENTS HIS AVERAGE THE TEAM WILL FORFEIT THE GAMES HE SHOT IN PLUS TOTALS.

IF A SHOOTER RETURNS TO THE MONDAY NIGHT LEAGUE HE COMES BACK AT HIS LAST KNOWN AVERAGE.

A TEAM THAT WINS 1st HALF, 2nd HALF, OR THE CHAMPIONSHIP HAS THE OPTION OF, TROPHIES, MUGS, PLAQUES, OR SHIRTS. TWENTY DOLLAR LIMIT FOR SHIRTS THIRTY DOLLAR LIMIT FOR OTHERS.

IF YOU WIN BOTH HALVES JACKETS AT SIXTY-FIVE DOLLAR LIMIT.

THESE RULES WERE PUT INTO EFFECT 8-31-92.

## 2009 / 10 Dart Season Updates

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### **ALL DARTS MUST BE IN THE BOARD TO COUNT**

If the next shooter goes up to the board and a dart falls out before he pulls them...

**IT DOES NOT COUNT**

So have your guys ready to shoot when it's their turn.

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All averages will continue from last years if you played... no more 3 weeks of shooting to start a new average.

All new shooters will continue to shoot 3 games to establish an average.

New shooters will come in at a 27

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All Dues (\$20), Drinks, Beer are the same as last year.

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Don't forget to buy 50/50 tickets to support the league.

A lot of guys never buy any. If we get a low weekly 50/50 dollar amount each week it will not cover expenses, and we will raise the weekly team dues.

no one really enjoys selling them each week, but don't make a quick run through the hall and pick a number just to get it over with..

November 3, 2003

A clarification of a rule was asked to be made last week after the league finished as follows:

What is the rule for all shooters on a team to finish shooting the 9<sup>th</sup> inning if they either have the game won or lost already??

There is no direct rule listed under the Rules of the League regarding this question.

However there is mention that shooters averages are computed at the end of regulation (9) innings.

So if a team has not shot the 9<sup>th</sup> inning to the end then they are breaking a rule as far as their handicaps being established for that game.

So if a game was not completed it has to be a forfeit....I would say however this has been going on as long as I can remember and no one has ever challenged or brought this up before to my knowledge.

So for a matter of record starting this the 9<sup>th</sup> week of the first-half of the 2003-04 season

All games must be shot to the end of 9 innings by all people shooting in that game or the game will be a forfeit.

This ruling can be challenged by the following rule.

The captains will also vote on whether or not an infraction to a documented rule has been committed, and if so, then they will vote on the penalty, if any, to be assessed to the individual or team in question.

## Monday Night Dart League Lucky Triples

To assist the 50/50 weekly drawing to support the league. (does not replace 50/50)

Each week a \$5 ticket will be sold to anyone wishing to get in the drawing to shoot.

All money from these ticket sales that night will be split into 3

One ticket will be picked that night and the name that is picked will shoot

3 darts at an inning that he rolls on a die (yes we have a 20 sided die)

Each triple hit in the inning rolled will get 1/3 of the pot with the exception

Of this: if a person hit the 1<sup>st</sup> 2 triples 1/3 & 1/3 of the pot the last dart will

Be worth 1/2 of the last 3<sup>rd</sup> to have some base money for the following week.

Example - say 30 tickets are sold the first week \$150 pot

Shooter drawn will get \$50 for each triple hit in the inning. (except if 1<sup>st</sup> 2 hit - see above)

If he hits the first 2 for 50 each the 3<sup>rd</sup> will be worth 25.

Whatever is not hit will be carried over to the next weeks pot and tickets sold will be added.

Example - say the shooter hits 1 triple he will get 50 the other 100 will be carried over

And say we sell another 30 tickets which will be 250 pot divided by 3 - \$80 per triple,

Money will be rounded off at my discretion. So if only 1 or maybe 2 trips are hit or none

The pot can grow very quickly.

Every week we will have the drawing and anyone can get in at anytime just by buying a ticket. This is a weekly shoot so it's just like the 50/50 you can't win if you don't play.

Weeks 1 thru 11. Drawing for shooter will be during 3rd game each week and they will shoot whenever they and me are ready or after he completes regular league games.

Since a lot of people don't show for 1<sup>st</sup> 2 weeks of playoffs the tickets will sell again During League Final / Free Night only each half. Whatever is not hit in the 1<sup>st</sup> half Finals 1/2 of that pot will go to the league with the other half carried into 2<sup>nd</sup> half with same rules as above except if after the 2<sup>nd</sup> half regular season ends. 1/3 of pot will go to league and the 2/3 and ticket sales will be pot for the Final with anyone taking a chance the pot will be split as usual If the person drawn does not clear the entire pot another name will be drawn with remaining pot and they shoot at inning rolled, and so on until pot it done. No carry over for next season.

Only Monday Night Members and Bartender can enter.

No buying tickets and having someone shoot for you or as a team split.

2 tickets max each week per person.

Remember this is to support the league - so teams will still sell weekly 50/50 tickets
